

SELF-DETERMINATION Information Meetings

Self-Determination is on the way across the state. This program will allow for a new way for the people we serve to have more authority and freedom in how their services and supports are planned and implemented.

What?

Informational sessions will be hosted at all TCRC offices this April with more planned for later in 2018. Come learn about Self-Determination and decide if you would like to submit your name for possible participation. You must attend an information meeting to participate.

The DDS is currently developing an online informational training where after reviewing the information about Self-Determination, those served and/or their legal guardian will be able to submit their information directly to DDS.

Questions about this process can be submitted to the Department via email at sdp@dds.ca.gov. Once the federal funding is approved, all Regional Centers will implement the program.

Who?

During the first 3 years 2,500 people across California can participate. DDS will randomly select based on diversity factors such as gender, ethnicity, disability, and age.

You must attend an information meeting about Self-Determination and sign an interest list to have your name submitted.

TCRC encourages those interested to visit the DDS Self-Determination web page for up to date information. The DDS website has Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) & updates and allows users to sign up for email updates.

On the List?

Verify that your name was submitted. Visit the DDS site <http://www.dds.ca.gov/SDPverification/index.cfm> You will need your Unique Client Identifier (UCI number) which you can find on your IPP or IFSP. Or call your service coordinator. Those on the list will get a confirmation letter from DDS.
